Job Goal: The SLP will work collaboratively with the classroom team to support the educational needs (IEP goals) of the student across the curriculum.

Qualifications:

1. Master's Degree in Communication Disorders. Certification required, either Type 73 or 10.
2. Expected to meet certain state licensing requirements.
3. Familiar with standard concepts, practices, and procedures.
4. Strong organizational and communication skills are required.

Duties And Responsibilities:

1. Provide small group and one to one instruction in a classroom setting to address the individualized educational needs of each student.
2. Provide services within a collaborative transdisciplinary team using an integrated model.
3. Design and support oral motor activities to enhance eating and/or verbal expression.
4. Design and support alternative communication systems: sign language, augmentative communication devices and pictorial or print communication systems.
5. Work flexibly with students of varying ability levels.
6. Collaborate with fellow team members in the development of goals and instructional strategies.
7. Implement medical and/or behavioral plans specific to student needs as necessary.
8. Demonstrate the ability to implement individualized behavior plans created by the classroom team.
9. Support and supervise educational support personnel.
