Education of Homeless Children

Each child of a homeless individual and each homeless youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, as provided to other children and youths, including a public pre-school education. A “homeless child” is defined as provided in the McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and the Ill. Education for Homeless Children Act. Based on homeless status, as determined by the member district, and eligibility for SASED Programs, SASED will provide appropriate services.
