Release Time for Religious Instruction/Observance

A student enrolled in a SASED program shall be released from school, as an excused absence, to observe a religious holiday or for religious instruction. The student's parent/guardian must give written notice to the Building Principal/Program Administrator at least 5 calendar days before the student's anticipated absence(s). This notice shall satisfy SASED's requirement for a written excuse when the student returns to school.

The Executive Director or designee shall develop and distribute to teachers, appropriate procedures regarding student absences for religious reasons and include a list of religious holidays on which a student shall be excused from school attendance, how teachers are notified of a student's impending absence, and the State law requirement that teachers provide the student with an equivalent opportunity to make up any examination, study, or work requirement.
