Expulsion Procedures

The final authority for expulsion of a student programmed educationally within SASED lies with the Board of Education of the student's district of residence. The policy provided within the district of residence for expulsion of students will be followed, including the due process procedures and compliance with the provisions of IDEA. No student with a disability shall be expelled if the student's particular act of gross disobedience or misconduct is a manifestation of his or her disability. A student with a disability whose gross disobedience or misconduct is not a manifestation of his/her disability may be expelled pursuant to the expulsion procedures, in accordance with the district of residence, provided that the student shall continue to receive educational services as provided in his or her Individual Education Plan (IEP) during the period of expulsion.
