

# SASED Behavioral Supports for Students

- Each SASED program uses a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) for addressing student behavior.
- A fundamental principle is that positive, non-aversive strategies and interventions should be used to the greatest extent possible to develop and strengthen desirable student behavior.
- A Behavior Management Manual ([hyperlink](#)), in which procedures and policies are outlined, is shared with parents annually.
- Behavior management procedures and policies are reviewed annually to ensure compliance with state statutes and best practice guidelines.
