



Parent/Guardian Self-Certification Slip

Parents/guardians are REQUIRED to check and date this form, and students are REQUIRED to present this slip to attend school (before boarding the school bus and before entering the school building). This slip certifies to us that students are free of symptoms and may report to school for In-Person Learning.

Do any of these symptoms apply to your student today?

- Fever of 100.4 F or higher
- New cough
- Shortness of breath
- New onset of moderate to severe headache
- Sore throat
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue from unknown cause
- Muscle/body aches from unknown cause

- Has the student been in close contact (6 ft or less for more than 15 minutes) with somebody who has recently tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

If YES to any of the above – your student is NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER THE BUS OR SCHOOL BUILDING without further screening. Call the program Secretary to notify SASED of the symptoms leading to the absence. Call your medical provider for evaluation, treatment, and information about when your student can return to school.

If a student tests positive on a COVID-19 diagnostic test or are diagnosed by a health care provider without a COVID-19 diagnostic test, the student must quarantine for 10 days and alert their health care provider. Students and staff members must be free of fever for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications and ensure that respiratory symptoms are improved by the end of 10 days.
